Voratus works through the current drawings, CAD, BOM, prototype information, supplier notes, manufacturing assumptions, assembly limitations, service requirements, sourcing constraints, and build risks, then marks up and structures the package for clearer supplier discussion, RFQ, procurement, assembly planning, or next-build execution.

### PRICING BASIS

Starting engagement from CAD \$12,500. Final scope confirmed before work begins.

### PRIMARY USE

Package markup, supplier-readiness preparation, build requirements, serviceability review, and controlled next-action planning.

### PACKAGE WORK

#### More than a report

- Review and mark up existing drawings, CAD views, BOMs, notes, requirements, supplier comments, and prototype evidence.

The base engagement is limited to a defined product, subsystem, assembly, or supplier package. Complex assemblies, extensive CAD production, drawing creation, redesign implementation, supplier management, testing, certification, or regulated engineering require separate scope and pricing.

## Service Terms

These terms apply to the Voratus Inc. Supplier-Ready Package Sprint unless replaced by a signed written agreement.

### Supplier-Ready Package Sprint

FROM CAD \$12,500

Final scope confirmed first. Taxes extra.

Scope, exclusions, reliance boundaries, site conditions, and commercial terms for this service.

**Scope of service.** The Supplier-Ready Package Sprint is a scoped package-preparation engagement for a defined product, subsystem, assembly, or supplier package. Voratus reviews, marks up, organizes, and identifies practical gaps in available technical materials for supplier discussion, RFQ, sourcing, assembly planning, or next-build execution. The sprint is not unlimited engineering and is not exhaustive.

**Business use only.** The service is offered for business, research, product-development, or commercial project use. It is not offered as a consumer household service.

**Client authority.** The person approving the quotation, submitting payment, authorizing work, or providing materials confirms that they have authority to bind the client and any project owner, sponsor, company, lab, or organization that will use or rely on the work.

**Client-provided information.** Voratus relies on drawings, CAD, BOMs, prototypes, supplier feedback, prices, constraints, and explanations provided by the client. Voratus does not independently verify accuracy, completeness, ownership, legality, safety, compliance, or suitability unless separately agreed in writing.

**Scope confirmation.** CAD \$12,500 is a starting engagement only. The final scope, included package elements, site work, documentation depth, assumptions, exclusions, and price are confirmed before work begins. Complex or expanded work requires separate quote or change order.

**Site access and safety.** If site work is included, the client is responsible for safe site access, escorts, permissions, required PPE information, site rules, and safe conditions. Voratus may refuse, pause, or leave unsafe, restricted, or unsuitable areas.

**Travel and expenses.** Travel, multi-location work, overnight travel, parking, freight, purchased components, special access costs, third-party fees, or supplier-facing expenses are excluded unless expressly included in the quotation.

**Fee and taxes.** The starting fee is CAD \$12,500, excluding applicable taxes. Taxes are added where required. Any final price above the starting fee is governed by the accepted quotation or written change order.

**Payment and start of work.** Work begins after acceptance of these terms, receipt of required payment or deposit, and receipt of the required project inputs. Payments are non-refundable once sprint work has started, except at Voratus' discretion.

**Delivery timing.** Delivery timing depends on complete and usable inputs, site access where applicable, client availability, and scope size. Incomplete, unclear, revised, or materially changed inputs may delay delivery, narrow the sprint, or require a separate quote.

**Deliverables.** Deliverables may include marked-up package comments, issue register, supplier-facing package map, BOM/spec/drawing gap register, assembly and serviceability notes, RFQ-support notes, supplier question set, and prioritized action plan, as confirmed in the accepted scope.

**Out-of-scope work.** Unless expressly included in the accepted scope, the fee does not include full CAD production, complete drawing creation, full redesign implementation, supplier management, procurement execution, testing, certification work, legal review, tax advice, safety-certification advice, regulatory approval work, or regulated professional engineering.

**Right to refuse or re-scope.** Voratus may refuse, pause, or re-scope the sprint if materials or site conditions indicate regulated work, safety-critical use, hazardous use, restricted products, unlawful activity, incomplete authority, missing information, or scope unsuitable for the accepted engagement.

**Cancellation or rescheduling.** Site days and calls may be rescheduled with reasonable notice. Missed appointments, late cancellations, lack of site access, unavailable team members, or unprepared project material may be treated as completed unless Voratus agrees otherwise.

**No stamped or regulated engineering.** Voratus does not provide stamped engineering, authentication, permitting, code sign-off, professional sign-off, or regulated professional engineering services under this offer. If licensed or specialist work appears required, Voratus may identify the likely handoff point.

**No certification or approval.** The service does not certify the product, approve it for manufacture or sale, confirm compliance, guarantee supplier acceptance, guarantee cost savings, or replace required testing, inspection, certification, regulatory review, or professional sign-off.

**Reliance and intended use.** Deliverables are for the client's internal project decision-making and supplier discussion only. No third party may rely on them without Voratus' written agreement. They are not production release, safety approval, compliance approval, or design verification documents.

**Client responsibility.** The client remains responsible for all design decisions, supplier instructions, release decisions, testing, validation, compliance obligations, commercial decisions, and final use of the product, process, or documentation.

**Third-party suppliers.** Voratus may comment on suppliers, sourcing, manufacturability, packaging, inspection, maintenance, pricing assumptions, or build risk, but does not control suppliers, manufacturers, certifiers, inspectors, carriers, or their outcomes.

**Confidentiality.** Voratus will treat client information, project materials, communications, supplier information, and findings as confidential and will not disclose them except as required to perform the service, with permission, or as required by law.

**Intellectual property and records.** The client retains ownership of its pre-existing designs, files, documents, and project materials. Voratus retains ownership of its pre-existing methods, templates, know-how, review approach, and internal working materials. Voratus may retain reasonable business and legal records.

**No duty to update.** Voratus has no duty to update any deliverable after delivery for later design changes, supplier changes, new information, test results, regulatory changes, or project decisions unless separately agreed in writing.

**Limitation of liability.** To the maximum extent permitted by law, Voratus' total liability for any claim arising out of or related to the service is limited to the fee paid for that service. Voratus is not liable for indirect, incidental, consequential, special, lost-profit, production-delay, supplier, launch, certification, regulatory, recall, rework, or commercial losses.

**No personal liability.** Any claim must be brought only against Voratus Inc. No director, officer, employee, contractor, representative, or advisor of Voratus has personal liability for any claim arising out of or related to the service.

**Client indemnity.** The client will indemnify Voratus against claims, losses, costs, and expenses arising from client-provided materials, inaccurate or incomplete information, unauthorized third-party reliance, external use of deliverables, intellectual-property disputes, supplier or manufacturing decisions, release decisions, unlawful use, unsafe site conditions, or use beyond the agreed scope.

**Claim period.** To the maximum extent permitted by law, any claim arising out of or related to the service must be started within one year after delivery of the final deliverable, failing which the claim is barred.

**Entire agreement and changes.** These terms, together with the accepted quotation, form the agreement for this service and override prior discussions, emails, website text, marketing statements, or informal communications about the same service. Changes must be agreed in writing.

**Severability.** If any part of these terms is found unenforceable, the remaining terms continue to apply as far as permitted by law.

**Governing law and forum.** These terms are governed by the laws of Alberta, Canada. Disputes must be brought in the courts of Alberta unless Voratus agrees otherwise in writing.

**Acceptance.** By approving the quotation, submitting payment, giving written authorization to proceed, booking a site visit, or providing project materials for review, the client accepts these Service Terms.
